North Central Texas College, Industrial Technology Center (ITC) Gainesville, Texas

A new 10,300 SF Industrial trades training facility for North Central Texas College's Gainesville campus. Known as the Industrial Technology Center or "ITC" is a one story all masonry constructed structure. The design fits into the context of the rest of the campus through the use of brick veneer and cast stone quoins matching the newer buildings on campus. The ITC is home to high-tech, state of the art equipment for hands-on training in Welding, Industrial Mechanics, and Machining labs. These training labs were carefully designed to help NCTC provide a first class education producing skilled workers in several fields expected to remain in high demand for years to come. The Welding Lab has 22 individual training booths and an adjacent Fabrication space equip with a 5-Ton girder crane providing the ideal space for more advanced training and projects. The Industrial Technology Center also incorporates the office functions for the ITC department faculty. The facility opened in March 2016.
